



Implementation Intervention and Evaluation

Implementation Intervention:

- New county expected practices and policies permitting evidence-based treatments
 - > DHS has behavioral health clinicians
 - > DMH clinics supported by leadership to offer smoking cessation services
 - ➤ Both DHS and DMH now have access to NRT, bupropion, and varenicline (supplied by Pfizer Pharmaceutics for DHS patients)
- Ongoing training, technical assistance, and decision support from DPH Tobacco Control, DHS Addiction Medicine, and TRDRP-Funded Clinical Experts
